Learn About Your Schools: ‘Dysart 101’ highlights financial, educational and human resources topics

DYSART SCHOOLS — In a complex organization like a school district with more than 24,000 students, approximately 2,700 employees and a budget with state cuts, understanding the current issues and operational focus can be a challenge. However, an upcoming series of classes hosted by the Dysart Unified School District will help to detail those complexities.

Designed for interested members of the community the district will hold a series of workshops, **Dysart 101**, to provide an overview of the district’s operations including budget and finance including information about the upcoming override election. Presented by Dysart administrators, classes are scheduled for three Tuesdays in January and February:

- January 26 – Overview of District Finance, Budgeting, Override and Facilities
- February 2 – Overview of Educational Services, Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment
- February 9 – Overview of Human Resources Operations

Meetings will be held from 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Dysart Education Center, 15802 North Parkview Place in Surprise, in the Governing Board room.
