Dysart school boundaries will not change for 2010-2011

DYSART SCHOOLS — For the first time in the last ten years, Dysart school boundaries will not change for the upcoming school year. Both K-8 and high school boundaries will remain the same for the 2010-2011 school year. School boundaries can be found at www.dysart.org.

In the past ten years, the Dysart District and its parents have faced yearly boundary changes due to hyper-growth in the community. Each year the district established a boundary committee to ensure that schools did not become over-crowded. According to Scott Thompson, Dysart's Executive Director for Business Services, "In each year of boundary change, we focused on finding a long-term solution which would stop the need for changing boundaries." While district enrollment continues to increase, the work that the boundary committees have done in the past has brought the district to a point where boundary changes are not needed for next school year. Looking forward, Dysart does not anticipate the need to re-examine school boundaries for quite some time. Thompson said, "The diligent work of the committees in the past have provided school boundaries which can accommodate student growth into the future."
