DYSART SCHOOLS — The Dysart School District is thankful to its community for the passage of the Dysart override on March 9. Unofficial results from the Maricopa County Elections Department show that voters supported the renewal of the Dysart override. The override renewal ensures that funding for the Dysart override will be continued next school year. The override renewal becomes effective for the next seven years. The Dysart Maintenance and Operations override was first approved by voters in 2000 and renewed again in 2004. The Dysart override provides funding for art, music, PE and band classes. Additionally the override guarantees funding for full-day kindergarten in Dysart if the state cuts the program.
