Summer food service available for all children

DYSART SCHOOLS — As part of the federal summer food service program, sites across the Dysart Unified School District will open this summer to provide free breakfasts and lunches to any children in the community who are 18 years old or younger.

The district's 2010 Summer Food Service Program begins May 24 and runs through June 17. Designated sites will serve breakfast from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. and lunch from 11:45 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Please refer to the list below for specific program locations.

Adults are welcome to accompany their children for both breakfast and lunch. Adults may purchase breakfast and lunch for \$1.25 and \$2.50 respectively.
