Dysart to use bus zones for student seating

DYSART SCHOOLS — When school begins on Monday, students and parents will see something new on Dysart buses, bus zones. Dysart will begin using bus zones during the 2009-2010 school year as a way of placing students by age group on its buses.

Students will sit on each Dysart bus according to grade range. Kindergarten through third grade students will sit together in a zone at the front of the bus. Fourth through sixth grade students will sit in a zone in the middle of the bus and seventh and eighth grade students will sit in a zone in the back portion of the bus. The zones will be identified by the use of primary colors.

Parents who would like to have their children sit together will find that their children will sit together in the zone with their youngest sibling. Dysart continues to refine the processes of its transportation department to provide the safest environment for students as they travel on the district's buses.

The use of the bus zones will begin the first week of school and will be monitored by the drivers and the transportation department. For more information about the bus zones, please contact the transportation department at 623. 876.7030.
