Special education parents asked to take survey

DYSART SCHOOLS — The Dysart School District is asking parents of special education students to participate in a parent involvement survey. The survey, found at www.ade.az.gov/ParentSurvey, collects data using a login system with unique user codes and passwords. The user codes and passwords have been sent home with each student as well as instructions for completing the survey. Parents can receive an additional copy of the information by requesting the items from their local school.

The survey, conducted by the Arizona Department of Education, is open through December 31. The survey is an important piece of the Arizona Department of Education's State Performance Plan and important to the Dysart Unified School District in complying with state and federal requirements.
