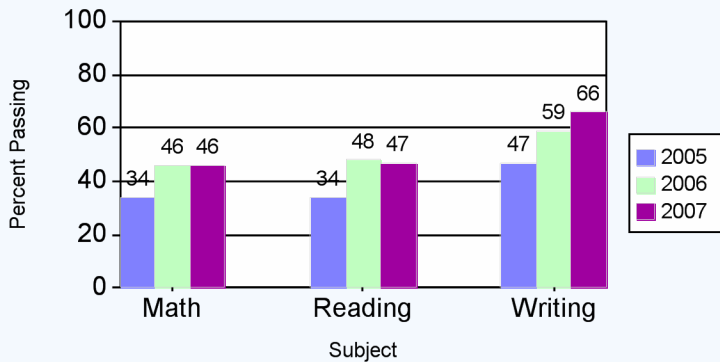
AZ LEARNS Profile For The School **Performing**

The Federal School Improvement Status **School Improvement Year 2**

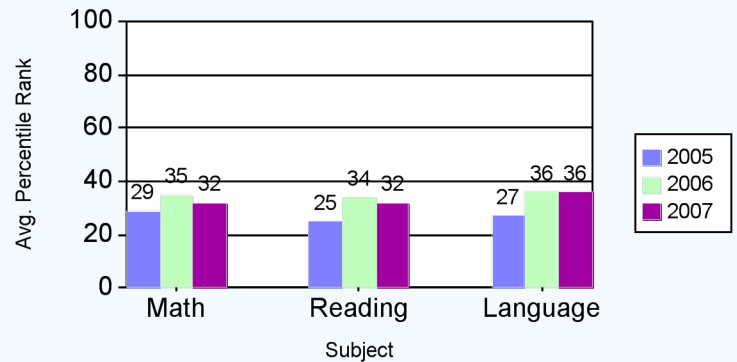
