The purpose of this meeting is to obtain public comment regarding the potential closure of Parkview Elementary School and to obtain public comment regarding potential boundary changes.

At this public meeting, attending members of the Dysart Unified School District Governing Board will hear reasons for or against closing the school and the proposed boundary changes. The public meeting shall not exceed sixty (60) minutes. During the public meeting, proposed attendance boundary changes including maps will be visually presented. Time shall be granted for public comments regarding the proposed attendance boundary changes and school closure. Speakers will be limited to three (3) minutes.

The Governing Board is considering these actions for the following reasons:

- To effectively position the district for the incoming and projected growth;
- To maximize the use of all available facilities;
- To use resources efficiently;
- To provide a traditional learning experience; and
- To provide the shortest bus routes possible

Individuals wishing to address the Governing Board must fill out a request form available in the lobby and turn it in to the board clerk, superintendent, or board secretary prior to the start of the meeting. Those who have asked to speak will be called upon to address the Board at the appropriate time.
