

Dear Parents,

In an effort to make a smooth transition into in person learning, we are asking that everyone comes prepared on September 14th. We initially sent out a supply list that was consistent with how we have done things in the past. Clearly, that is going to be different this year. Below you will find a list of "must haves" for the first day of school. These are items your child should already have been using during remote learning. We understand that for some families this may be a hardship. Please reach out to your child's homeroom teacher if you are unable to get the items listed below so that we can make sure we gather extra supplies before the first day back.

Must haves: (Please label all items)

- Pencil Box:
 - 2-4 pencils
 - 1-2 pink erasers
 - Pair of scissors
 - 1-2 glue sticks
 - 24 count box of crayons
 - 12-24 count package of colored pencils
 - 1 package of markers (optional)
 - Highlighter
 - 1-2 dry erase markers
 - Personal pencil sharpener with a cap to hold shavings
- 4 Composition Notebooks (Math, Reading, Writing, and Science/Social Studies)
- 5 Folders (Math, Reading, Writing, Science/Social Studies, and Work in Progress)
- Package of 3-hole binder paper, wide ruled
- Bottle of hand sanitizer to be kept at desk
- Water bottle
- Headphones or earbuds

If you would like to send in extra supplies for us to use to refill your child's supplies as the year progresses, please put them in a clearly labeled gallon ziploc bag. We will store them and use them to replace items for your child as needed.

There are some items we would be very grateful for. These items are difficult to get and we do not want families to feel additional pressure or stress.
