 - a. STEAM Day - Friday before fall break was our school-wide STEAM day. Students presented their STEAM projects to their fellow students and to the Maricopa County Education Superintendent Steve Watson and Dysart Unified School District Superintendent Dr. Quinn Kellis. It was a huge success.
 - b. GCU STEM Impact Grant - Shark Tank - students will be presenting a STEM project at Grand Canyon University in an attempt to win an \$8,000 grant to implement their STEM project and benefit our community.
 - c. Scott Flansberg - Human Calculator - Principal Miller met Scott Flansberg, World Record holder for mental math, while taking students to the AZ SciTech Kickoff Conference. He offered to come out and did a presentation for our 2nd-8th grade students just before fall break.
 - d. Softball Team went to playoffs
 - e. Teacher of the Year - Sheri Loyd was named one of the four Arizona Teacher Ambassadors for Excellence for 2019.
 - f. Roxanne Lopez won a \$5,000 STEM grant to purchase materials for the iExplore Lab and will be honored at the Fiesta Bowl in December.
 - g. The MVS Choir was able to participate in the Dysart Festival of Choirs at the beginning of October. They will also be participating in a District-wide Fine Arts Festival in April! And one of the 2nd grade classes and choir will be singing at MVS' Veterans Day Celebration on November 8. The 5th-8th grade choir will also be singing at the Arizona Coyotes' December 1st game.
