- Students will be required to complete the senior check-out sheet prior to graduation. Forms will be handed out during 3rd hr. on Monday, May 6th. The completed form is due to the counseling office by the end of the day (3PM) on Friday, May 10th.
- Students are highly encouraged to pay all fees to the bookstore/cafeteria and return all books to the library by Wednesday, May 1st. Final due dates to pay fees/return books are as follows:
 - Library: Tuesday, May 7th
 - Cafeteria: Wednesday, May 8th
 - Textbook/Bookstore Fees: Wednesday, May 8th/Thursday, May 9th**All fees must be paid and books returned to be eligible to walk in the graduation ceremony.**
- Senior Exams are Thursday, May 9th, (1, 2, 3 hrs.) and Friday, May 10th, (4/5, 6, 7 hrs.). These are full days of school (7:15 a.m. -2:15 p.m.).
- Graduation rehearsal will be held on Monday, May 13th, at 1:00 p.m., in the WCHS auditorium/gyms. School **dress code** will be strictly enforced. Attendance is **MANDATORY**. You may not be allowed to walk in the graduation ceremony unless you have pre-approval in WRITING to be absent, if you have a *valid* reason. Letters for pre-approval must be submitted to Ms. LoMazzo ASAP.
- Caps and gowns will be distributed on Monday, May 6th, from 7:15 a.m. - 10:15 a.m., in the auditorium lobby, to those who pre-ordered them. If you have not ordered your cap and gown, you can order them online at www.esbalfour.com or by phone at 623-385-8230.
- Remember there is a dress code for graduation. Dress nicely- NO jeans, flip flops or tennis shoes. **NO** decorations or additions to the cap and gown will be allowed other than approved club/organization regalia. Students will be sent home to change as necessary and could be prevented from walking in the ceremony. **NO** cell phones or purses - they will be confiscated at check in so they should be left with a family member. Caps and gowns should be brought in hand to the ceremony and put on once students are in the stand-by room at the stadium.
- Students should arrive at 12:30 p.m., for the graduation ceremony at the State Farm Stadium. Students will enter through Gate 2.
- Dr. Wieferrich, Principal, held "Senior Talks" on Tuesday, March 26th, to brief the senior class on all graduation information and expectations. The PowerPoint presentation can be viewed on the WCHS website.

STATE FARM STADIUM PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST

The following items are not permitted inside State Farm Stadium. There are no provisions to store items not allowed through security and items cannot be held by security staff members.

- Aerosol Cans
- Alcohol
- Animals (except for service animals)
- Bags not in accordance with the NFL Clear Bag Policy
- Balloons
- Banners or signs larger than 3' x 2'
- Beverages other than one (1) factory sealed, non-frozen 500m; (16.9 fl.oz.) plain bottle of water (sports drinks and flavored water are not permitted)
- Beverage containers – Bottles, cans and thermos bottles
- Brooms
- Cameras with professional photo lenses
- Chewing tobacco
- Clothing deemed obscene or indecent
- Coolers of any kind
- E-cigarettes or vaporizer pens
- Fireworks
- Folding chairs
- Food (except for children under the age of two)
- Footballs and beach balls (inflated or deflated)
- GoPro cameras
- Illegal Drugs
- Laptop computers
- Laser Pointers
- Mono/tripods
- Noise makers (whistles, horns, bells, etc.)
- Poles or sticks of any kind, including “Selfie-Sticks”
- Umbrellas larger than 12 inches in length
- Video cameras
- Weapons – including, but not limited to, firearms & knives
 - Any item deemed inappropriate or hazardous by stadium security
