

Continuous Improvement Goals 2023-2024

Mission: Kingswood mission is to create a collaborative community of learners achieving at the highest level.

Vision: Succeeding every day... every KNIGHT!

Goal: By May 2024, Kingswood will:

- ★ Reduce the number of minimally proficient students by 50% in math and ELA based on AASA.
- ★ Reduce the number of identified ESS students from minimally proficient by 50% on 22-23 AASA to score partially proficient or higher in math and ELA
- ★ Increase at least 1 developmental level for ELL students in any of the four assessed areas; Reading, Writing, Speaking, and Listening as measured by the 23-24 AZELLA.
- ★ Increase the number of proficient students by 10% in math and ELA based on AASA
- ★ Increase the percentage of students in grades K-3 at or above benchmark by 10% and decrease the strategic and intensive students by 15% using DIBELs.
