Integrated Action Plan

Goal 1

- ★ By May 2024, K-3rd grade students will increase percent of students at or above benchmark by at least 5% as measured by DIBELS composite score. By May 2024 the number of K-3rd students at intensive will decrease by 5%.
- ★ By May 2024 3rd-8th grade students will increase proficiency scores by 3% or greater in ELA and Math as measured by AASA.
- ★ By May 2024, 3rd-8th grade minimally proficient students will decrease by 5% in ELA and Math.

Action Steps:

- By August 31, 2023, teachers will receive professional development on the criteria of the Dysart Instructional Protocol and self-reflect on current instructional practices.
- By September 2023, data sweeps with the Dysart Instructional Protocol, along with face-to-face feedback, and sharing of longitudinal data will occur monthly.
- By November 2023, the targeted number of Riverview students will be predicted to be proficient or above on the State Test and teachers will monitor and adjust based on student need.
- By December 2023, all collaborative teams will have professional time to meet with the principal, assistant principal, teaching and learning specialist, and interventionists review relevant data as evidenced by walkthrough data, professional learning agendas, and academic data.
- By March 2023, the targeted number of Riverview students will be predicted to be proficient or above on the State Test and teachers will monitor and adjust based on student need.

Goal 2

- ★ By May 2024, K-8 behavior referrals will decrease by 10%.

Action Steps:

- By August 31, 2023, staff will receive training in school-wide behavior and feedback on consistent implementation of the RVS behavior flow chart including positive reinforcements.
- By September 2023, all collaborative teams will identify any students for the RTI process and identify specific and targeted interventions (RTI for both academics and behavior).
- By October 2023, all teachers will have made 5 or more positive phone calls each month and will continue monthly through May 2024.
- By December 2023, Instructional Cabinet will convene and reflect on what is working with the system and what is not and make adjustments accordingly.
- By May of 2024, Riverview teachers will celebrate 100% of their students with a positive phone call.

Goal 3

- ★ By May 2024, 100% of Riverview teachers will be active members in their weekly collaborative time working within the PLC model.

Action Steps:

- By August 31, 2023, all staff will receive initial training on implementing PLCs and setting grade level norms use of agenda template. In addition, ongoing training and monitoring will occur throughout the year, and receive feedback from the leadership team.
- By September, each grade level will identify SMART goals in reading and math and will continue quarterly.
- By May 2024, all staff will evaluate the effectiveness of their PLC based on Learning by Doing PLC rubrics.
