Hi all!

The goal of Dysart High School is to open up opportunities for students to be successful beyond their high school career. The state of Arizona requires 22 credits for high school graduation and that all students be College and career-ready through the CCR Index. When students earn points on the College and Career Index showing that they are College and career-ready, this opens up pathways of opportunity.

There are multiple ways for a student to gain the skills to be ready for the workforce or postsecondary education. A few examples are being a CTE concentrator, which means a student has completed at least two years of a CTE pathway earning c's or better and passing their credential exams, completing Dual Enrollment classes with a C or better, completing a work-based learning program or internship, taking and passing AP exams with a 3 or higher scoring proficient on the ACT.
