- If you meet your requirements after our graduation up until July 2024, you will still get a 2024 diploma but you will not miss your chance to walk at graduation.

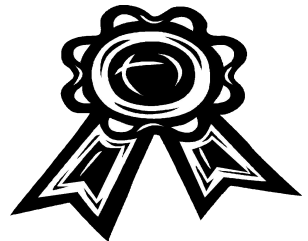
Honors and Awards Ceremony

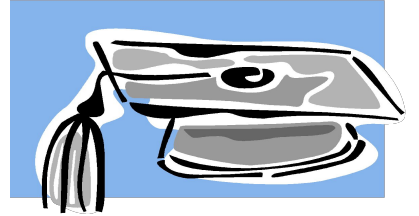
The Graduation Process

 - Following practice you will pick up your cap and gown at the Auditorium Lobby

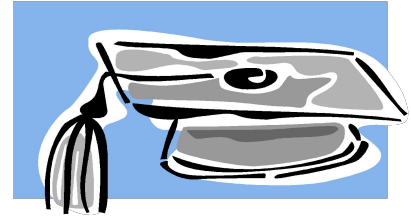


The Graduation Process
