I. REGULAR MEETING - GENERAL FUNCTION

1. Ms. Traci Sawyer-Sinkbeil, Governing Board President, called the regular meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Governing Board members constituting a quorum were present; Ms. Traci Sawyer-Sinkbeil, Ms. Christine Pritchard, Mr. Jerry Eynon, Ms. Jennifer Tanner and Mrs. Bonnie Schroader.
2. Dr. Dave Dumon led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. A motion by Sawyer-Sinkbeil/Pritchard was entered to approve the Agenda Form consistent with Board Policy and temporarily suspend any Governing Board Policy with which the agenda may be inconsistent. UNANIMOUS
4. Summary of Current Events
 - Dysart received the Association of School Business Officials International's (ASBO) Certificate of Excellence in Financial Reporting award for having met or exceeded the program's high standards for financial reporting and accountability for the fiscal year ending 2011.
 - Due to technical difficulties the Spotlight Video, Bring Your Own Device, was not shown.
 - Superintendent Update
 - In partnership with the City of Surprise and Channel 3TV, Dysart will sponsor an awareness program on Rachel's Challenge at the Valley Vista Performing Arts Center on August 22nd. Invitations from Mayor Wolcott, the district, Channel 3TV and the Rachel's Challenge Foundation have been sent to educational, civic, government and business leaders. I presented information to our Regional Chamber of Commerce Board this afternoon. The interest is very high and we are hopeful this can become a community supported initiative with our district's schools as an anchor.
 - Opening of School and Enrollment/Staffing Report – This year Dysart welcomed nearly 25,700 students an increase of almost 800 students over last year's 100th day count. The District currently employs over 2,989 staff. The growth is not evenly distributed across all campuses so some schools are now closed to open enrollment due to the growth. Transportation did a great job with considering they have to do more with the same amount of resources. Our buildings and grounds were in excellent shape and once again that is with fewer resources available to maintain those facilities. Dr. Pletnick thanked our dedicated staff for keeping students first and getting the job done regardless of the challenges.
 - Governing Board Update – Board members welcomed staff back and expressed their excitement with the start of the school year.
