21. Exceeding Standards, Future Ready: School Data Days

Dr. Hall, Valley Vista Principal, and Ms. Winterstein, Principal Sunset Hills, reported how these sites utilize iPal.
22. Information Regarding the Hake Index or Normalized Gain
The Hake Index is being used in the District to help teachers and administrators set reasonable goals for continuous academic improvement. Hake measures the distance in closing the gap between where a student is in relation to achieving 100% growth. The Hake Index is used by teachers to track the growth of individual students. Those students with low or no growth are targeted for intervention.


